

## Check Ride

Anyone who obtained their Learners Permit on or after April 2nd 2016 **will** be required to complete a Check Ride prior to undertaking a motorcycle licence assessment. If you obtained your Learners Permit prior to April 1st 2016 then you **will not** be required to complete a Check Ride (and will be eligible to undertake your motorcycle licence assessment after you have held your learners permit for a minimum of three months).

**Course Duration:** Half Day – (Approximately 4 hours) Maximum Client: Trainer ratio - 5:1

- U-Turns, Curves & Braking
- Riding Tactics & Strategies
- A Pre On-Road Briefing
- On-Road Coaching
- A Post-Check Ride Debriefing and Group Discussion

**Pre-requisites & Entry Requirements:**

- A current Victorian Motorcycle Learner Permit; having held it for no longer than 14 months. This must be brought with you on the day of the check ride.
- A current Victorian Drivers Licence card; brought with you on the day of the check ride.
- Wear appropriate protective clothing, including long sleeves/pants and fully enclosed shoes, either boots or runners.
