

## **Motorcycle Learner Permit**

Course Duration:

2 Days – (Approximately 8 hours per day)

Maximum Client: Trainer ratio - 5:1

Course content:

Day 1:

- · Non-powered and powered basic skills
- Slow riding
- · Skills consolidation
- · Theory assessment

## Day 2:

- Review of day 1
- · Warm up ride
- Motorcycle controls including weaving, changing paths, braking and crash avoidance
- On-range assessment
- · On-road training and on-road assessment

Pre-requisites & Entry Requirements:

- · Be at least 18 years of age.
- A current Victorian Driver's Licence card; brought with you on the day of the course.
  If you don't hold a current Victorian Driver's Licence, please contact VicRoads to ensure you complete any necessary theory testing/conversions before the course.
- · Obtain a Victorian Rider Handbook and study before the course.
- · Wear appropriate protective clothing, including long sleeves/pants and fully enclosed shoes, either boots or runners.

**Training materials:** 

The VicRoads publication 'The Victorian Rider Handbook' must be studied prior to the course; this can be purchased from VicRoads offices, Armstrongs office or it can also be downloaded from the VicRoads website.

Assessment:

Assessment includes:

- A written theory component, based on the VicRoads handbook (this assessment must be successfully completed to continue on to the practical assessments)
- · 2 practical assessments, one on-range and one on-road
