- Pre-operational vehicle inspections and checks
- Starting, steering, manoeuvring, positioning and stopping in accordance with regulations
- Reversing, maintaining visibility and achieving accurate positioning
- Parking, shut down, uncoupling and securing according to manufacturer's specifications
- Aligning and coupling in proper sequence (Prime mover and trailer)
- Performance and efficiency of vehicle operation
- Efficient and permissible routes of travel
- Hazard identification and avoidance (defensive driving)
- Procedures to be followed in the event of a driving emergency

Pre-requisites & Entry Requirements:

- A current Australian Driver's Licence and a Heavy Combination Licence; a secondary form of ID is also required; please refer to Armstrong's Terms & Conditions for details.
- Wear appropriate clothing, including fully enclosed shoes, either boots or runners.

Assessment: Assessments include:

- A written assessment (which must be successfully completed prior to any further testing)
- Practical assessment in cabin drill and vehicle inspection
- Off-road reversing (straight line)
- Coupling and Uncoupling
- An on-road drive assessment
